



3.00PM Extreme Weather Response

What is Extreme Weather

- Heavy rain/flooding
- Hail
- High winds/cyclone
- Fire

What will happen for the students:

- The school will text parents to inform them that we are enacting our Extreme Weather Plan.
- Students will be directed to the Hall to be collected by parents/carers at 3.00pm, or until extreme weather passes.
- Students that usually walk home or ride bikes will be directed to the Hall, parents will be contacted for any alternative arrangements.
- Students that catch the bus home, will be directed to the library where arrival and departure can still be monitored.
- The school will text parents when this Extreme Weather Plan has concluded.

What will parents/carers do:

- Monitor Facebook for updates
- The school will use our Facebook Page to keep parents up to date with information as weather passes and text parents when it has finished.
- Students will not be released to be collected from Stop, Drop & Go, they will be held in the Hall until weather passes.
- Parents/Carers can collect as per normal at/after 3.00pm - from the Hall.
- Parents may prefer to wait for weather to pass before collecting students from the Hall.
- The school will coordinate with OSHC to move students that are booked in, to them, when safe.
- If weather passes, parents will be informed through text and our Facebook Page and collection from Stop, Drop and Go will begin.
- Monitor communication from bus companies (this communication comes directly from the bus company NOT the school) about any changes to bus timetable.
