I, the Honourable Jarrod Bleijie MP, Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister Industrial Relations, give notice that under section 38 of the *Planning Act 2016*, I made a Ministerial Infrastructure Designation (MID) for the Ipswich Health Precinct on 19 August 2025.

Description of the designated premises
