

# Investing for Success

**Under this agreement for 2018  
Jimboomba State School will receive**

**\$272,107\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the number of students in the upper 2 bands (year 3 reading) to 40% in 2018 (NAPLAN).
- Increase the percentage of students achieving A-C achievement on report cards in English (prep – year 2) to 80%.

## Our initiatives include

- Provide tiered literacy intervention to students in prep to year 2 with an emphasis on metalinguistic and phonological awareness skills.
- Provide tiered literacy intervention to students in prep to year 2 to improve reading comprehension skills using actions including thinking within the text, thinking about the text and thinking beyond the text.
- Provide feedback to teachers on the explicit teaching of reading.
- Successful transition into prep through the Implementation of the Jimboomba Jumpstart program – transition to prep in term 4.
- Implement an oral language program for identified students in prep – year 2.
- Enable teachers to plan units of work in English using the Australian Curriculum – using achievement standards and providing opportunities to moderate to ensure consistency of teacher judgment.
