

# Investing for Success

## Under this agreement for 2019 Jimboomba State School will receive

**\$268,698\***

### This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English from 47% in year 2 (2018) to 50% in year 3 (2019).
- Increase the percentage of students in the upper 2 bands (year 3 reading) to 46% in 2019 (NAPLAN).

### Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching targeted at students requiring additional support in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year level achievement standard.
- Enable teachers to observe and provide feedback to each other around the explicit teaching of reading using processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice.
- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for planning and moderation in school and across schools.
- Implement an oral language program for identified students in Prep – Year 2.
- Implement the Jumpstart program for pre-prep students to enhance knowledge of prep entry expectations and to assist in a smooth transition of children into primary school.
