

# Investing for Success

## Under this agreement for 2020 Jimboomba State School will receive

**\$284 150\***

### This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'B' standard or above in English from 46% in year 2 (2019) to 50% in year 3 (2020).
- Increase the percentage of students in the upper 2 bands (year 3 reading) to 45% in 2020 (NAPLAN).

### Our initiatives include

- Provide focused and intensive teaching targeted at students requiring additional support in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year level achievement standard.
- Employ an early year's coach to strengthen the knowledge of all staff in prep - 2 + local early childhood centres around age appropriate pedagogies, early start and the use of early start data and the Abecedarian approach.
- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for planning and moderation in school and across schools.
- Implement an oral language framework for identified students in Prep – Year 2.
- Implement the Jimboomba Jumpstart program for pre-prep students to enhance their preparedness and to assist in a smooth transition into primary school.
